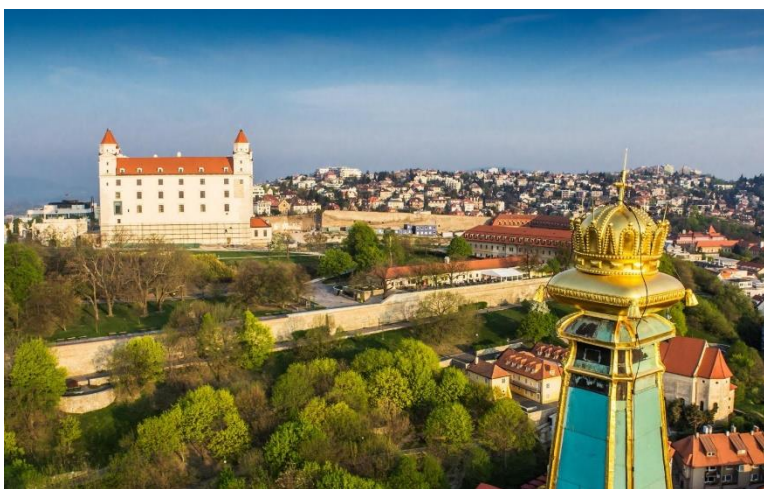

Continue via St. Michael’s Gate along former House of Hungarian Parliament to Cathedral of St. Martin. End of the tour at Bratislava Castle from where is a superb view on Bratislava.

Small Carpathians is a winegrowing region located in south – eastern slopes of the Small Carpathians Hills and is one of the eight-winegrowing regions of Slovakia, moreover along Slovakian part of Tokaj Region is the most important. Arrival in Red Stone Castle, entrance to Red Stone Castle one of the most romantic castles of Slovakia. Afterwards continue to Modra – a historical wine growing town and continue to Pezinok – a capital city of wine production in Slovakia. Wine degustation of local fine wine in stylish wine cellar. On the way back to Bratislava stop in Svaty Jur – walking tour in beautiful historical city center. Return back to Bratislava. Drop of at the client's hotel or in city center.

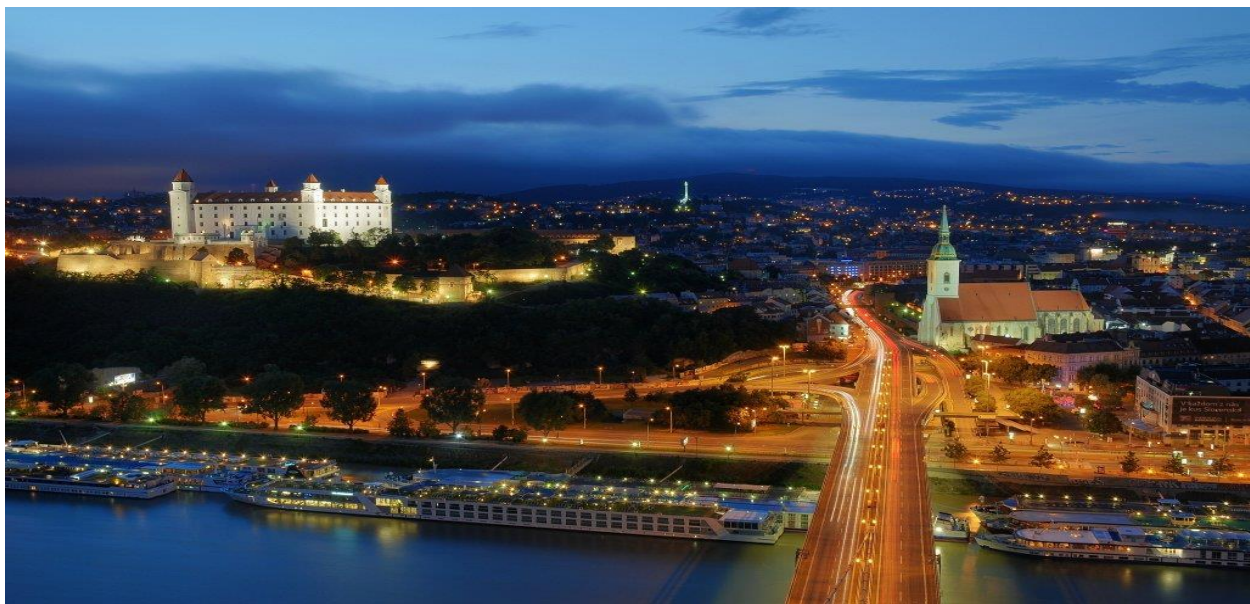


Bratislava by Night
Duration max 2 hrs.

Bratislava is presented as the city of the delicious cuisine and good wine. This tour will show you Bratislava during the evening, when the colors of the town are changed from the daily light.

Meeting with the guide in front of main entrance to Park Inn by Radisson Danube Hotel, or in the client's hotel in Bratislava city center. Walk up the hill to Bratislava Castle- a symbol dominant feature of Bratislava, which stands at a strategic site above the Danube. The site was inhabited as far back as Celtic and Great Moravian Times. The castle was the place of summit of Mr. G.W. Bush / Mr. V. Putin in Feb 2005. From Bratislava Castle is a superb view on Bratislava & Austria. Continue walking down, through historical areas and streets and arrive at Bratislava National Theater Opera, Slovak Philharmonic Orchestra- Reduta Building. Continue in sightseeing tour and cross of the Danube River and arrival at UFO Attraction. Admiration of Bratislava in night from tower from opposite side as from the Castle. Dinner at the iconic UFO restaurant. Return back at the hotel.

Historical Cities – Trnava, Topolcianky & Nitra

Duration: max 12 hours

Discover with us the south part of Slovakia, one of the prettiest regions of Slovakia in terms of architecture. Trnava and Nitra are two oldest cities of Slovakia and both as seats of bishop and Trnava archbishop are full of sacral buildings and monuments. Moreover, worth to see is also Topolcianky Castle, located in small town Topolcianky close to Nitra.

Meeting with the guide at the lobby of your hotel. At first transfer to historical city Trnava, which is famous thanks to great volume of sacral buildings. Therefore also the nicknames of this city are either „Slovakian Rome“ or „Small Rome“. Walking tour in historical city center. Possible entrance to St. Nicholas’s Cathedral. Continue to Topolcianky, famous thanks to a castle which was the summer residence of first Czechoslovakian president Tomas Garrigue Masaryk. Second highlight of Topolcianky in addition to the castle is a Slovak National Stud Farm. Continue to the oldest city in Slovakia – Nitra. Free time for late lunch in Nitra. Nitra is also well known as a „mother of all Slovak cities“, as Nitra was in Great Moravian times the political center of state and also a very first church in Slovakia was built in Nitra. Visit of upper & lower city. In upper city entrance to beautiful St. Emeram Cathedral, located above the city. In Nitra is also possible to taste Slovak national peculiarity – Mead (alcoholic). Return transfer to Bratislava.

North Slovakia Tour – Cicmany & Vratna Valley

Duration: max 13 hours

North Slovakia is famous thanks to unspoiled nature and rich folk traditions. Let's discover with us this beautiful part of Slovakia which is reachable from Bratislava as a one day trip and get know with Slovak traditions.

Meeting with the guide at the lobby of your hotel. First transfer to Cicmany, one of the most famous Slovakian villages. It is famous thanks to the wooden houses which are painted by white ornaments – so called "Cicmany Pattern". Continue to Rajecka Lesna where is located the biggest wooden crèche in Slovakia, which shows Slovakian folk traditions and crafts. Continue thru SPA town Rajecke Teplice to the most beautiful valley in Slovakia – Vratna Valley. Cable car to Snilovske Sedlo Peak (1524 meters above sea level). Afterwards go on to one of the most well know villages of Slovakia – Terchova. Terchova is famous not only as a summer/ ski resort but also thanks to Terchova's folk music which is listed on UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE LIST and as a birth place of Slovakian national hero – Juraj Janosik, who was a bandit who according to the legends took from the riches and nobility and gave to the poor. Transfer to Zilina, a center of North – West Slovakia, walking tour in beautiful historical city center. Return transfer to Bratislava.

Castles of Slovakia – Bojnice & Trencin

Duration: max 11 hours

Although Slovakia is a quite small country, it is rich by the castles, strongholds and manor houses. In Slovakia there is more than 180 castles and more than 300 manor houses. Let's discover with us two of the most of attractive – Cinderella Bojnice Castle and majestic Trencin Castle.

Meeting with the guide at the lobby of your hotel. At first transfer to SPA town Bojnice, where is located one of the most beautiful castles of Slovakia – The Bojnice Castle. First written notice about the castle is dated from 1013 in list from Zobor Abbey. The castle got its current look after the reconstruction which took from 1888 till to 1909 under ownership of Lord Jan Pallfy. Castle is by its looking similar to castles on river Loire in French, entrance to the castle. Free time for a lunch in Bojnice. Transfer to Trencin, one of the most ancient cities of Slovakia. Trencin is well known thanks to castle located above the city and also thanks to first written notice in Slovakia, which is on rock under the castle and testify about presence of army of Roman Emperor Marcus Aurelius in Slovakia. Walking tour in historical city center of Trencin. Return transfer to Bratislava

Royal Mining Cities Of Slovakia – Banska Stiavnica, Kremnica & Banska Bystrica
Duration: max 12 hours

Central Slovakia has rich mining history and in the past this region was one of the richest regions of former Austro – Hungarian Empire, thanks to mining of gold and silver, which shows unique architecture of these beautiful cities.

Meeting with the guide at the lobby of your hotel. At first transfer to Banska Stiavnica, which historical center is part of UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE LIST. Banska Stiavnica is also called "Silver Stiavnica" as silver was mined there. Arrival in Banska Stiavnica and walking tour in beautiful historical city center. Afterwards either entrance to New Castle or to mining museum. Free time for a lunch. Transfer to Kremnica, "Golden Kremnica". On the way short stop in the oldest SPA town in Slovakia – Sklenne Teplice. Walking tour in beautiful historical city center of Kremnica. In the town is located the oldest mint in the world, which still works. Possible entrance to Kremnica Castle. Continue to Banska Bystrica, the center of Central Slovakia. Banska Bystrica during 2nd World War was center of Slovak National Uprising. Walking tour in historical city center of the city. Evening return transfer back to Bratislava.

Imperial Vienna

Duration: max 11 hours

Bratislava and Vienna are two closest capital cities in Europe. Take advantage of short distance, as Bratislava is located just one hour from his „older brother“Vienna and discover with us this imperial city.

Meeting with the driver at the lobby of your hotel. Transfer to Vienna. As it was said Bratislava and Vienna are two closest capital cities in Europe and probably also in the world. Both cities are „crown cities“, as in Vienna were crowned the Austrian Emperors whilst in Bratislava were crowned the Hungarian Kings. Meeting with your guide in Vienna, and discovering Vienna during Grand City Tour of Vienna (1 hour by bus and 2 hours on foot). A drive along the Ringstrasse gives you the opportunity to see the city’s most significant historical sights. Afterwards, take a short walk around the most beautiful parts of Vienna: Hofburg, Kartner Strasse and St. Stephan’s Cathedral. Lunch in traditional Viennese restaurant. In afternoon either free time in city center or visit of Schönbrunn Palace. Return transfer to Bratislava.

Royal Budapest

Budapest and Bratislava have more common that you expect. Both cities not just lie on both banks of Danube river, but both cities were in past capital city of majestic Hungarian Empire. Budapest is located about 2, 5 hours drive by bus from Bratislava.

Meeting with the driver at the lobby of your hotel. Transfer to Budapest. A short 2, 5 hours drive from Bratislava on the motorway directly to Budapest. Bratislava has common history with Budapest, in both cities of former Hungarian Kingdom, Kings & Queens were crowned and also just in these two cities had seat the Hungarian Parliament. Meeting with your guide in Budapest. Grand City Tour of Budapest (1 hour by bus and 2 hours on foot). Visit of Buda district with Buda Castle, St. Matthias Church, and Fisherman’s Bastion. Drive along Andrassy Avenue – Opera House, House of Terror, continue along Hungarian Parliament. At the end enjoy a short walk around Hero’s Square and the City Park. Free time for lunch in traditional Hungarian restaurant – Csarda. In the evening possible to swim in famous Szechenyi Spa or entrance to beautiful Hungarian Parliament. Evening return transfer to Bratislava.
